As we journey through the season of Epiphany the season of light, the" Revelation of God" When the Gentile Magi come to worship Jesus, they show that everyone now has access to God. Now all people Jew and Gentile, can come to God's temple to worship, because Jesus is the new temple, God in the flesh. The season of Epiphany begins with the Magi's visit and ends at the Transfiguration, when three of Jesus' disciples glimpse their Lord in divine splendor, seeing Him as the center of the Law (Moses) and the Prophets (Elíjah). Jesus proclaims to His disciples then and now, that He is the long awaited one who has come to die for the sins of the world and be raised again in glory. The Transfiguration of our Lord is the last Sunday before Lent. In Lent, we prepare our hearts for our crucified and risen Lord. The lyrics of this song written by Mann Curtis and Billie Campbell brings these seasons to life as we journey with Jesus to the cross of Easter.
