Now summer is just around the corner (June 20th) and I find myself wondering, are we ready? What do you plan to do with these warm beautiful months? Our family will be traveling to Wisconsin for our daughter Katy's wedding in early July and I can't tell you how exciting that will be!

Will any of you be reading this summer? I thought I might make a few suggestions for those of you who might be looking for some ideas. A great book that is quite recent would be *The Shack* by William P. Young. It's an easy to read story with some very difficult subject matter (the violent death of a small child and her father's inability to deal with her death), but it's handled with incredible

creativity and sensitivity. I have a copy of it if you would like to borrow it. Another is *Joshua* by Joseph Girzone. *Joshua* is a modern parable written by a retired Catholic priest – in it, he wonders, what would it be like if Jesus appeared at our church one day and then remained in our town for quite some time? The book is in our church library.

A somewhat more difficult read, but very rewarding, is the book *Gilead* by Marilynne Robinson. It's a fictional autobiography of the Reverend John Ames. John is a Congregationalist pastor who is dying of a heart condition. The book chronicles his memories of his father and grandfather and was written as something for his seven year old son to remember his father by.

John's memories are sometimes rather disturbing, but I found myself grabbed deeply by the very humanness of this story.

A great old classic, *Chronicles of Narnia*, by CS Lewis has been getting a lot of attention in the last few years with the release of film adaptations of the first few books in the series. The films are fun, but the books are still the best – if you have the time.

Another thought for the summer is worship attendance. I know many of you do travel and if you do, consider using the ELCA's website (www.elca.org) to find an ELCA church in whatever town or city you end up in. It's an easy way to find local congregations. Chances are you will feel pretty much at home in one of them. If you do end up attending one, please consider dropping off a copy of a bulletin from one of their services in our church office. I'm

raisers we wouldn't be able to do many of the projects we do. Great Job!

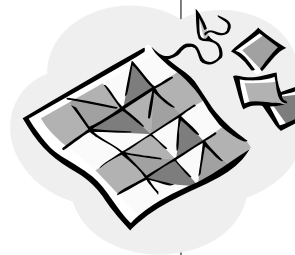

Minutes from the May Council Meeting

Meeting was called to order by President Joe Hoiberg at 8:05 p.m.

Present: Joe Hoiberg, Loretta Bloomquist, Ron Heisler, Marlene Young, Pat Berggren, Mary Jane Stubbe, Ray Sletteland, Roger Knutson, Darci Gilbertson, Jamie Travers. **Absent:** Pastor Jeff, Mary Jane Blanchfield, Cara Mitzel, Stacy MacDonald, Karen Lindseth.

Devotions were given by Jamie. Topic – If we had one hour to live – what is important? Reading from Luke 10.

Minutes: Ray moved, Roger 2nd and carried to approve the minutes as published in the Spire.

Treasurer's Report: Loan is paid. Current balance in Designated fund is \$39,968.45. Marlene moved, 2nd by Mary Jane and carried to approve minutes and pay the bills.

Reports:

Pastor Jeff: March 25th - baptized Sequiya Ina Arellano Baker, Cohen Juwan Flyinghawk and Kiwon Nateavia Baker. There were no weddings. Three funerals in April, all presided over by Pastor Reuben Schnaidt: Leonard a Schlieve on April 9th, Mildred Alice Foss Herda, and Hyllis Johnson McDaniel on April 27th. I led Holy Communion worship services at Park Place on Thursday, March 15th & April 16th; Presided over Holy Communion services at the Odd Fellow's Home on Sunday, March 11 and Sunday, April 1st; Presided over Holy Communion service for Chaplain Rachel Johnson at Heartland Care Center on Tuesday, March 31st; On Tuesday, March 20th helped lead a second council meeting for the month of March. The topic of discussion was staffing, ideas for evangelism and invigorating our life together here at St. Olaf. The conversation was wonderful and I left with a spring in my step and lots of ideas in my head! Since then Jamie and I have been discussing different changes coming – stay tuned. In a similar vein, on Tuesday, May 1st, I met with Joe Hoiberg, Russ Pearson, area pastors and Pastor Keith Zeh from the synod office to discuss the possibility of setting up what he calls



Mission Tables here in the Devils Lake area to do just the kind of thing that our council did a few weeks ago. I led guitar services on March 25th, at the 9 am worship on Sunday, April 8th (Easter), and on Sunday, April 29th. There will be one more this month on the 27th. Attended a Devils Lake conference meeting of pastors and associates in ministry at Edmore on Tuesday, April 10th. Wednesday, March 28th we finished up our book study, Lenten's soup suppers and our final Wednesday evening service. I was pleased and amazed at the attendance each week. It was just plain gratifying! Guitar classes for middle school kids finished up today, May 8th. Two students will be playing along with Russ this Sunday before the 8:30 am service. Helped serve the Klub/Ham/ Kraut dinner. This year I was finally persuaded to eat the Klub. Although I felt full for the next four days, I enjoyed it. Took vacation after Easter from Monday, April 9th through Saturday, April 14. Attended the Eastern North Dakota Synod Assembly on April 21st & 22nd. It was a great time to get to know some of St. Olaf's leaders better, as well as to be fed with worship and Holy Communion led by others. Finally, gave the message at the WELCA memorial service on May 3rd.

Lay Ministry: Met May 8th. All present. Motion by Florence, 2nd by Delores and carried to approve the minutes. Delores is making weekly visits at the Good Sam and helping with hair care. Ron Miller is a new member so Lay Ministry duties were reviewed.

Men's club has had the Klub feed. Closed with devotions. **WELCA:** The Bible Study was led by Jamie at the April 12th evening meeting. Lydia Circle was in charge of the program, with Connie Whitney giving information on Swing Bed at Mercy Hospital. Lunch was served by Anna Circle. Members helped make lefse to sell at the Club supper, and doughnuts for the rummage sale. The Memorial Service was held May 3rd with the Prisca Circle presenting the program, remembering the 10 members we have lost in the past year. Prisca Circle also served lunch. Quilts and kits were packed to be sent to Lutheran World Relief. The spring rummage sale was May 5th with rolls and doughnuts served for morning coffee. Noon lunch included barbecues and pie. The spring Cluster Meeting was May 5th at Rolette.

Outreach and Evangelism: Met on Sunday, May 6th, 2012 between services at 10:00 a.m. at St. Olaf Lutheran Church. Present: Kim Hatten, LaMae Bergan, and Patricia Berggren. The committee explored ideas for speakers from community agencies to speak between services during coffee hour. It was decided to limit this to four months of the year during the less busy times of the year at the church and to speak to Darci to find out what months would be the best to do this. It was also decided to have the first speaker come in the fall. There was also discussion whether to have the speakers present during coffee hour for about 15 minutes or whether to have them speak a few minutes between services and then again at the 11:00 service. The committee decided that that could be

decided on later. Another topic discussed was the idea of making and giving fleece tie blankets to programming youth at the Lake Region Law Enforcement Center when the youth are to be discharged. Patricia will find out if this would be allowed by the facility. The committee also discussed what committee members could do to help out with the 125th anniversary celebration. consultation about making better use of our current equipment. We need all committee members together to discuss the Anniversary Celebration plans.

New business: Russ Pearson will lead an informal group to practice June 6th at 7:30 with the idea of providing special music at 8:30 or 11:00 services in the summer. Families, singers of all ages and abilities are welcome to come together and sing. We plan on practicing just once or twice in a month and sing once or twice in a month. Meeting adjourned. Lynda Pearson.

Unfinished Business: Jamie presented a slide show of the results from the faith survey. People surveyed were grouped into 5-9 grade youth, senior high, teachers, and some other adults. The results showed younger and older people consider church and faith important. This declines dramatically in senior high youth. College age are putting aside their faith and not returning to church as they start families as they once did. We need to teach a "sticky" faith. He passed out graphs illustrating results to various questions.

New Business:

St Olaf is named in Leonard Schlieve will. Details not known yet. Retreat Center: Roger moved, 2nd by Ray and carried to begin 8:30 service at the Retreat Center first Sunday in June until the last Sunday in August with the exception of the July 15th Sunday 125th Celebration when both services will be at St. Olaf.
